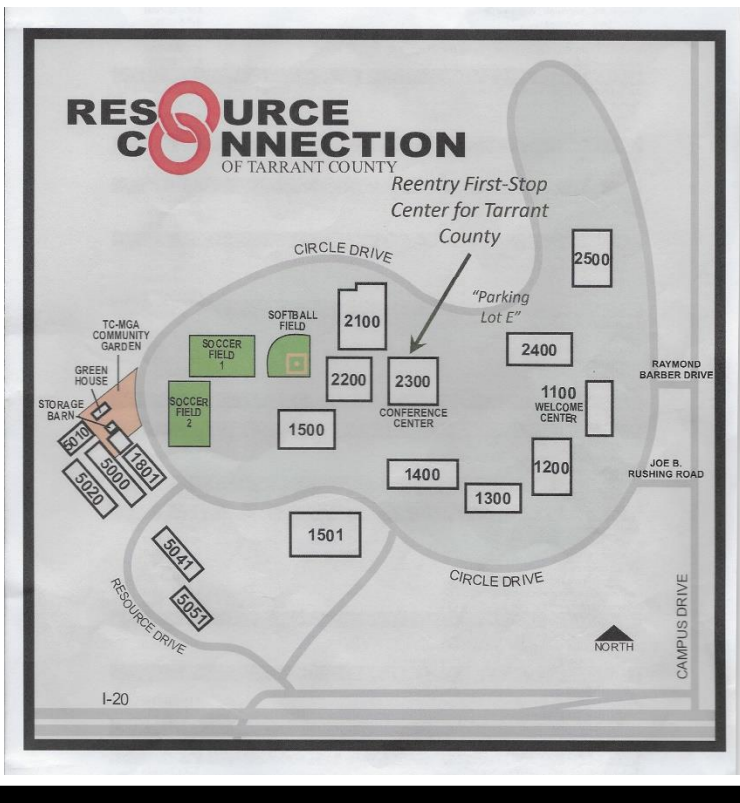


**Find Us:** Exit 439, Campus Drive, on I-20 in Fort Worth, Texas.

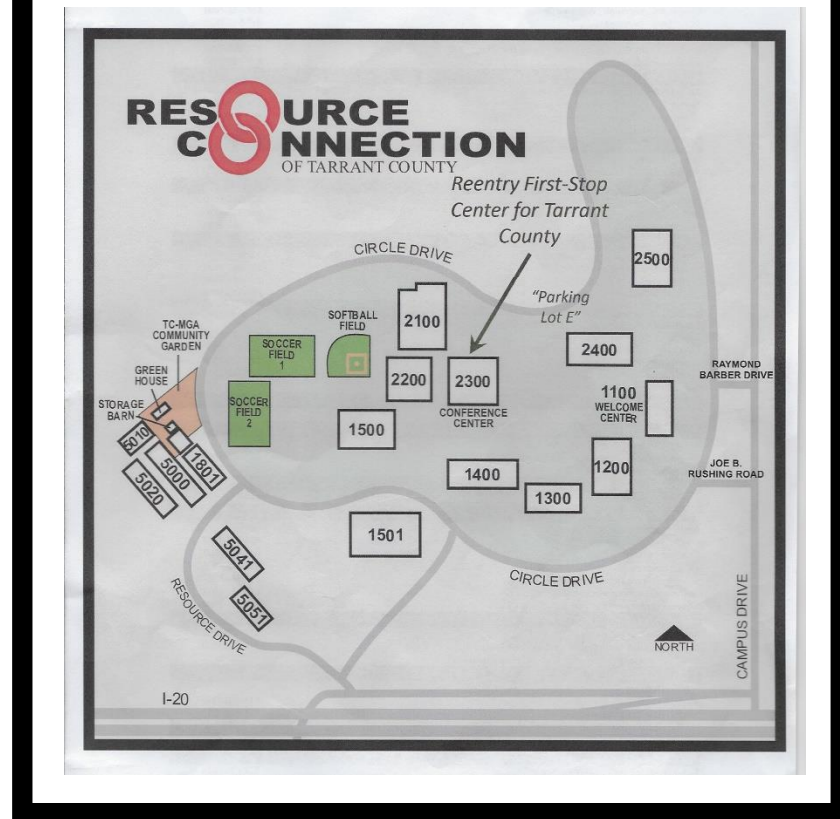


**Find Us:** Exit 439, Campus Drive, on I-20 in Fort Worth, Texas.
